Dinichthys (di-NICK-thees) was a 30 foot long (9.1 meters) fish with large, sharp teeth that could chop off seaweed. Ophthalmosaurus (op-THAL-mo-SAW-rus), "eye reptile," had no teeth, but had sharp eyes that were as large as soup bowls. It did not lay eggs like dinosaurs, but kept its babies inside its body until they were born alive in the sea. Nothosaurus (NOTH-oh-SAW-rus) had a fin on its tail and webbed feet to help it swim deep in the ocean.
